## Communications services

## Telephone calls

Parents may call may call 904.271.6700 and ask to be connected to the patient's nurse. You will be given a code that you must have when you call. We encourage you to call whenever it is convenient for you.

## Visitor guidelines

For your child's well-being and the care of other patients, we ask that you limit the number of visitors to two people per family per day. All visitors must be accompanied by one of the baby's parents/legal guardians, and visitors other than the baby's siblings must be over 18 years old.

We encourage prearranged sibling visits of up to 15 minutes, as long as the child(ren) are over 5 years old. Please fill out a sibling health clearance form prior to each visit.

If you have special visitation requests, please discuss them with your baby's social worker or nurse.

## For your baby's safety

To help prevent infection, we ask that everyone entering the unit perform a three-minute hand and forearm scrub before going to a baby's bedside. Please wash your hands or use the alcohol disinfectant any time before or after you touch your baby. You will see our staff doing this, too.

To keep your baby safe and to maintain confidentiality, you will be given a code that you must have when you enter the unit or if you call for phone updates. It is our hospital policy to only provide information to parents or legal guardians.
